



Three friends are exploring their neighborhood when they stumble upon an abandoned yard. With the help of their neighbors, they turn this forgotten space into a beautiful garden.






Over in the Garden JE ABC123 MAT

Who keeps eating all the lettuce Toot and Puddle have planted in their garden? It's a mystery that must be solved so they have vegetables all summer long.



With the help of her stuffed bear, a little girl transforms a vacant lot in her city into a vibrant community garden for all to enjoy.






