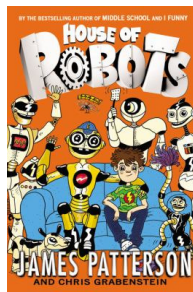


Frank Einstein: and the Antimatter Motor **J SCIESZKA/FRA #1**

After machines take control of Earth, following the extinction of humans, a 12 year-old robot confronts its prejudices about humans after discovering and befriending a 12year-old human girl.

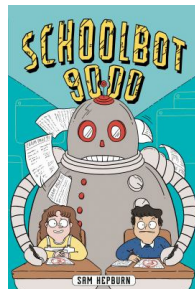

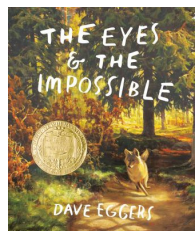


Little Robot **J GN HATKE, B**

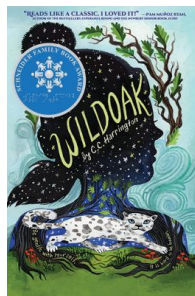

Free dog Johannes' job is to observe everything that happens in his urban park and report back to the park's three bison elders, but things are changing and he needs the help of all the animals.

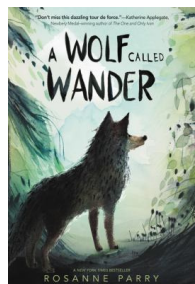

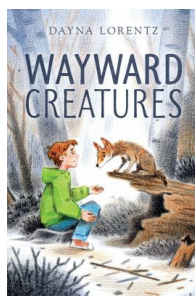

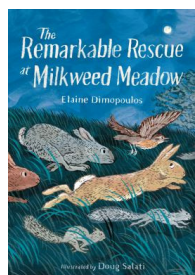

A troubled 12 year old boy befriends a wayward coyote after a forest fire changes both of their lives. They will each need the other to heal and find peace.

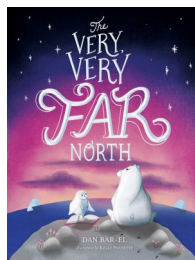

Butternut, a young rabbit who loves stories, makes friends among the other animals and birds and convinces them to help her rescue a litter of orphaned coyote pups.

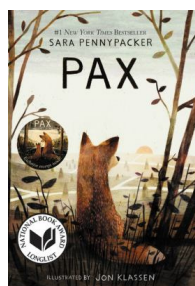
