

**RESOLUTION NO. 3272**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CANVASS OF VOTES OF THE MAY 19, 2026, PRIMARY ELECTION.**

WHEREAS, at the Primary Election held on May 19, 2026, the electorate of the City of Wilsonville cast ballots for one measure, Ballot Measure 3-632 Amends Charter to require voter approval for Urban Renewal Plans; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 3-632 asked the following question “Should the Wilsonville Charter be amended to require voter notification and approval to create or substantially change Urban Renewal Plans?”; and

WHEREAS, the Primary Election of the registered voters of Clackamas and Washington Counties was conducted by mail; and

WHEREAS, the County Clerks of Clackamas and Washington Counties, respectively, are by statute, in charge of conducting all elections, and both counties have filed an abstract of the tally of votes cast at the election, which tally for Clackamas County and Washington County was duly received by the City Recorder on June 12, 2026, copies of which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the City Council of the City of Wilsonville does hereby adopt the votes of May 19, 2026, Primary Election as follows:
